



Poinsettia

Plant Care

- Place your plant in indirect sunlight for at least six hours per day. If direct sun can't be avoided, diffuse the light with a shade or sheer curtain.
- Provide room temperatures between 68° - 70° F.
- Water your plant when the soil feels dry to the touch.
- Use a large, roomy shopping bag to protect your plant when transporting it. At near freezing or freezing temperatures, normal for Christmas time, the plant is quite susceptible to cold injury.
- Fertilize your plant **AFTER THE BLOOMING SEASON** with a balanced, all-purpose fertilizer.
- Don't place plants near cold drafts or excessive heat. Avoid placing plants near appliances, fireplaces or ventilating ducts.
- Don't expose plants to temperatures below 50° F. Poinsettias are sensitive to cold, so avoid placing them outside during the winter months.
- Don't overwater your plant, or allow it to sit in standing water. Always remove
